These have been the highest temperatures for a month of March, since 1943.

The Brazilians were instructed to avoid all sun exposure, and to hydrate themselves.

Some beaches were crammed with people, like the ones in Ipanema and Copacabana, this Sunday. The current climate has already warmed by about 1.2°C compared to 1850–1900

Up to 500 millimetres of water could fall, while in February the state of Rio Grande do Sul was suffocating with heat due to an "extreme heat dome" from Argentina.
