New Zealand – maori – symbols/ narration

Enregistrement 1

Peter and Suzy are looking for the rugby ball. They are in New Zealand. They meet an old Maori.

“What are you doing here, children?”

- We’re looking for the rugby ball for the World Cup.

- I don’t know where it is. But I had a dream: a long time ago, it was dark, very dark; the stars were behind the clouds; under the moon, an eagle met a snake by the water (river). The clue is in the story.”

Wales - château + dragon/ description/There is there are

Enregistrement 1

Peter and Suzy are looking for the rugby ball. They are in Wales. They meet Merlin in his castle.

“Welcome to my castle. Please come in. There are two staircases. Up the left one, there is a green door and there is a grey door. Behind the grey door, there are two paintings. In one painting, there are two towers. Behind this painting, there are two keys. The key with the hand opens the secret room. In the secret room, the dragon will give you the clue.

Scotland - Highlands games/ verbes d’actions / he can – he can’t

Enregistrement 1

Peter and Suzy are looking for the rugby ball. They are in Scotland. They meet a Scottish boy, Jim.

“Can you guess who my favourite sportsman is.

First, find the four activities Paul, John, Jack and Andrew practice.

- Paul - number 73: he can throw a rock, throw a tree and lift a rock but he can’t carry a rock or pull a rope.

John – number 76: he can carry a rock, pull a rope and play the bagpipes but he can’t throw a rock, lift a rock or run a race.

Jack – number 79: he can throw a rock, throw a tree and play the bagpipes but he can’t carry a rock or pull a rope.

Andrew- number 77: he can lift a rock, carry a rock and pull a rope but he can’t play the bagpipes or run a race.

Enregistrement 2

Now listen carefully and guess who my favourite sportsman is.

“He can carry a rock, pull a rope, throw a tree and play the bagpipes. The clue is with my favourite sportsman”.

Enregistrement 1 (clue)

Where is it? That is the clue!
