A 5 year old boy accidentally shot his 2 years old sister to death in southern Kentucky with a rifle he had received as a gift last year for his birthday, the authorities said. The little girl, Caroline Sparks, was killed by a single shot to her chest fired by her brother, Kristian. The family had not realized a bullet had been left inside it.
